





ASER - Citizen Led- Household Based- All Children Nationwide enrolled and un-enrolled 3-16 years




ASER

- A nationwide one -on -one Learning Assessment for lower primary-at HH level
- Government assessments at grades 5 and 8; sometimes grade 4 too
- High Stakes Board Examinations Grades 9,10,11 and 12

 - "This is the first time, thanks to the availability of the ASER dataset, that techniques of analysis pioneered and used in more developed countries to assess the social segregation of public service users can be applied to a large high-quality dataset from Pakistan" Siddiqui, N., Gorard, S. (2017).
- However, the ASER dataset is the largest of this kind of information available that can be linked for analysis between parents, children, proficiency of children in reading, arithmetics and English, schools and regions at a national level.


ASER Triggers: A Children's Literature Festival another Social Movement in 2011!

- Children's Literature Festival(CLF) initiated in 2011 as a response to ASER Findings created as an out of the box locally crafted solution
- CLF is about beyond "textbooks and tests" a feeling, learning and healing festival!
- CLF- Anthem- "Hamain Kitab Chahiyeh" *I want a book; I want a curriculum that can transform lives*" by world renowned Urdu poet "Zehra Nigah"
- CLF varies in size, space & resources: National; Provincial, District & School Level First time Govt. of Sindh has sponsored-district and school CLFs!
- CLF is an Equalizer calling All students from ALL schools to engage with learning that is creative- promoting reading- and critical thinking - 32 CLFs across Pakistan-600,000 attendees! over 1 million readers of CLF publications!
- CLF has mobilized 150+ national/internationally acclaimed resource persons who move
 now CLF Ambassadors
- 14 Strands of experiential learning:reading with expression; poetry/prose; art of bookmaking; digital learning;theatre;music; book launches; 'bol kay lab azaad hein teray' speak for your lips are free open speak by children; book-stalls
- Publications: bi-monthly magazine "Uran Tashtaree- flying saucer" and 10 commissioned children's literature books- child prodigies being discovered ..

- ASER also working on the disability dimension


EYAs on the March


